To find the Riverdale Volunteer Fire Department take Highway 67 / State Street East out of Bettendorf, IA till you reach the ALCOA Plant (the plant will be located on the right hand side of the Highway 67 as you travel East out of Bettendorf) The next stop light after the Alcoa's Main Entrance will be the corner of Manor Drive and Highway 67.
